OBJECTIVES AND ORGANISATION

FESASS, the European Federation for Animal Health and Sanitary Security, brings together more than one million livestock farmers in its member organisations, representing 85% of the European livestock population. It is a technical organisation whose main aim is to defend and promote the health status of European livestock farming. As such, it organises days dedicated either to the management of a specific disease (Tuberculosis, BVD, Johne's disease), or to broader issues relating to European animal health policy and its practical application to livestock farming (Animal Health Law, Epidemiological surveillance, Control of AMR).

These days provide an opportunity for professional representatives, veterinarians and technicians from our member organisations to meet up, exchange information and discuss their experiences and the problems they have encountered, while identifying guidelines and recommendations for longer-term action.

OBJECTIVES OF THE FESASS' DAYS 2023

These FESASS' days are organised in the frame of the implementation of the European Strategy for a Sustainable Production from Farm to Fork (F2F), at a time when many health threats are developing on the European Union's borders and throughout its territory. In this context, it is essential to put animal health back at the heart of the discussions and actions to be taken. This means working on the strong links between Animal Health and the new challenges of Sustainability, Animal Welfare and the Quality of our products.

Announced in autumn 2019 during the Elvas Days in Portugal by our Vice President Delegated to the Health Quality and Safety of Products of Animal Origin, Mr Vito AMENDOLARA, the organisation of these days has been delayed due to the COVID pandemic. But their objective remains unchanged, and they are still highly relevant to European livestock farming

PRACTICAL ORGANISATION



Italy, its livestock farming and AIA occupy a special place in this context. Italy is directly exposed to the consequences of global warming, whether in terms of the emergence or re-emergence of animal diseases or threats to animal welfare (drought, heatwave, etc.). In addition, the livestock sector, and in particular the AIA, has developed a pioneering system for monitoring and promoting the quality of animal products.

The decision to hold these days in Rome was therefore also taken to gain a better understanding of Italian livestock farming, the country's health organisation and the AIA's activities and constraints. The aim was also to enable a privileged and direct exchange with the farmers and veterinarians of this Member State. AIA is one of FESASS' founders. With its local and regional components, it provides a remarkable network in Italy, ensuring proximity to the farmers and practising vets. These are essential assets for guaranteeing the quality and variety of exchanges during these two days.

In practical terms, and given the complexity of the issues addressed, we have decided to focus the first half-day on the technical aspects and the second on the more political dimension of the relationship between Animal Health and these challenges.

These days will take place in the exceptional surroundings of Palazzo Rospigliosi, the headquarters of COLDIRETTI (the Italian farmers' union).

These days will be interpreted in English, French and Italian.


- Registrations can only be made using the <u>online form</u>

Rome airport transfers to city centre

- The most used airport in Rome is Fiumicino Leonardo da Vinci. It is located more than 34 kilometres from the city centre. It has an excellent rail connection: the Leonardo Express. It takes you to Rome Termini station in 32 minutes. The train runs every 15 minutes and costs € 17.90. There are also buses (50 minutes/€7) and taxis (40 minutes/about €50).
- The second Roman airport is Ciampino, which is located 16 kilometres southeast of the centre of Rome. It is smaller. There is only the bus (buy your ticket in advance) or the taxi.


Meeting venue: How to get to Palazzo Rospigliosi



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
